THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

---of me WILLIAM PASKE of 30 Elgin Crescent in the county of London late a Major  
---General (retired) in Her Majesty's Indian Army I give devise and bequeath all the  
---property which I may die possessed of or entitled to unto and to the use of my  
---trustees hereinafter mentioned Upon trust that my trustees shall sell call in  
collect and convert into money the said real and personal estate in such manner as  
they shall think fit and so that they shall have the fullest power and discretion  
to postpone the sale calling in or conversion of the whole or any part or parts of  
the said premises during such period as they shall think proper without being respon-  
sible for loss and shall out of the moneys to arise from the sale calling or conver-  
sion of or forming part of my said real and personal estate pay my funeral and testa-  
mentary expenses and debts and shall out of the residue pay the following legacies  
that is to say To my daughter Annie Emily known as Daisy Paske the sum of two thousand  
pounds To my trustees the sum of eight hundred pounds upon trust for investment and

to apply both income and capital at their discretion for the benefit of my son Robert  
Macrone Paske To my son Arthur Goldingham Paske the sum of one thousand pounds To my  
son William Lake Paske the sum of seven hundred pounds To my son George Frederick  
Paske the sum of six hundred pounds To my daughter Agnes Amelia Werninck the sum of  
two hundred pounds To my daughter Mabel Mackenzie Mackie the sum of two hundred  
pounds To the Reverend Frederick Werninck the sum of one hundred pounds To my grandson  
Wynn Werninck fifty pounds To the Vicar of St Johns Church Ladbroke Grove for dis-  
tribution amongst the poor of the parish twenty five pounds I give devise and be-  
queath all the property which I may die possessed of and not otherwise disposed of  
by this my will or any Codicil hereto unto my children by my first wife in equal  
shares I appoint my son Arthur Goldingham Paske and George Lipscombe Matthews of 26  
Cannon Street in the city of London Solicitor to be EXECUTORS AND TRUSTEES of this  
my will And I declare that any trustee or executor for the time being hereunder being  
a Solicitor shall be entitled to charge and be paid all usual professional charges  
and emoluments notwithstanding his acting as one of my executors and trustees IN  
WITNESS whereof I the said William Paske have to this my will set my hand this 28th  
day of June one thousand nine hundred and five - WILLIAM PASKE Maj Genl -  
Signed by the above named Testator as his last will in the presence of us present at  
the same time who in his presence and at his request and in the presence of each
