my Sisters the said Sarah Pask Florence Ann Maria Pask
Ruth Elizabeth Pask and Agatha Pask in equal shares or -
the survivors of them that shall be living at the time of my
death I direct that should either one or more of the said

the others and at a price to be mutually agreed upon -
